- My learning goal is to use finger spacing in my writing.

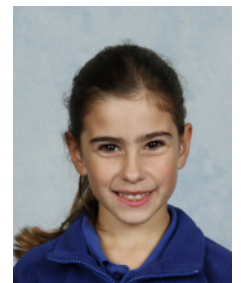
