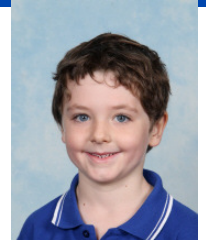

Parent Teacher Interviews

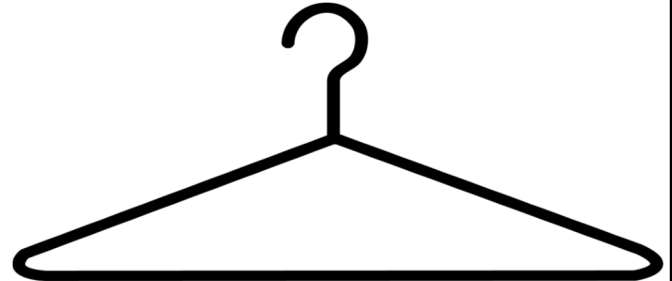
