- My learning goal is to finish my 8 x tables.

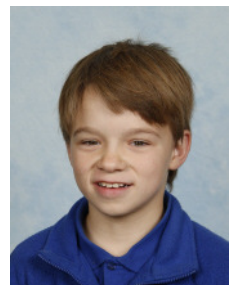
