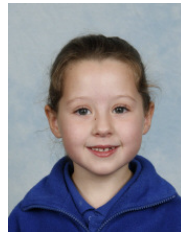

- My learning goal is to get my green belt in punctuation.

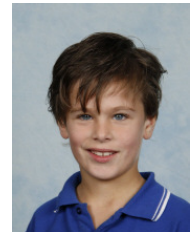
