Home Learning Policy

PURPOSE:

1. To provide a basis for the allocation of home learning
2. To establish for students, teachers and parents desirable home learning practices.

BROAD GUIDELINES:

1. Home learning provides students with the opportunity to reinforce and practice skills learned at school.
2. Home learning encourages students to improve their organisational and time management skills and develop their sense of responsibility.
3. Home learning gives students the opportunity to complete unfinished tasks.
4. Home learning gives parents an opportunity to assist children's learning.
5. All Home learning will be corrected.
6. Students who do not complete homework complete it in Time In.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. Students in years 3-6 will be set Home learning as a compulsory exercise.
2. Home learning for Prep-2 includes daily reading and spelling words.
3. Home learning includes tables, spelling, reading and set tasks.
4. The year level allocations are:

Year 3&4

- No more than 1 hour per week in addition to daily reading, spelling words and tables.

Year 5&6

- No more than 2 hours per week in addition to daily reading, spelling words and tables.
5. Home learning will be set on a week by week basis during term. Students who do not complete Home learning may be required to complete the set work at school.
 6. Home learning shall relate to current classroom curriculum.
